WHEREAS, the Papago Council is desirous of maintaining a sound educa-1 tional program for the Papago people; and 2 3 WHEREAS, the Papago Council finds it necessary to recontract and 4 redesign the Community Education Contract Program in order 5 to meet the needs of the Papago people; and WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the Papago Tribe to conduct 6 7 and control its own educational programs. 8 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that the Bureau 9 of Indian Affairs, Papago Agency is hereby requested to 10 enter into recontracting and redesigning the Papago Commu-11 nity Education Program according to P.L. 93-638 regulations 12 and guidelines, to meet the needs of the Papago people. 13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the budget in the amount of \$40,000.00 14 plus indirect costs to be added thereto, a copy of which is 15 attached hereto and made a part hereof, is hereby approved. 16 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on 8th day of October, 1976, at a meeting at which a quorum was 17 present with a vote of 834.0 for; n against: 0 not voting; and 2 absent; pursuant to the authority vested in the Council by Section 2 (a) and (k) of Article V of the Constitution 18 and By-laws of the Papago Tribe as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of 20 June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
