


RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

RES. NO. 65-76


1 WHEREAS, the Papago Council is desirous of maintaining a sound educa-
2 tional program for the Papago people; and
3 WHEREAS, the Papago Council finds it necessary to recontract and
4 redesign the Community Education Contract Program in order
5 to meet the needs of the Papago people; and
6 WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the Papago Tribe to conduct
7 and control its own educational programs.
8 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that the Bureau
9 of Indian Affairs, Papago Agency is hereby requested to
10 enter into recontracting and redesigning the Papago Commu-
11 nity Education Program according to P.L. 93-638 regulations
12 and guidelines, to meet the needs of the Papago people.
13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the budget in the amount of \$40,000.00
14 plus indirect costs to be added thereto, a copy of which is
15 attached hereto and made a part hereof, is hereby approved.

16 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on
17 the 8th day of October, 1976, at a meeting at which a quorum was
18 present with a vote of 834.0 for; 0 against; 0 not vot-
19 ing; and 2 absent; pursuant to the authority vested in the
20 Council by Section 2 (a) and (k) of Article V of the Constitution
21 and By-laws of the Papago Tribe as amended, ratified by the Papago
22 Tribe on December 12, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of the
23 Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of
24 June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of
25 the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency
26 and is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
