

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

RES. NO. 74-76

1 WHEREAS, the village of Kaka has investigated the possibility of
2 establishing a plant to manufacture clay floor tiles and
3 found that assistance will be given them only if the plant
4 is a free enterprise for the people of Kaka; and

5 WHEREAS, financing will be available only if the plant is a free
6 enterprise for the people of Kaka; and

7 WHEREAS, the male population of Kaka, except for a few on CETA, are
8 supported by TWEP and are frequently reminded TWEP is a
9 welfare program and they should look for employment; and

10 WHEREAS, Kaka is an isolated village and very few employment opportu-
11 nities are available near the village; and

12 WHEREAS, the men of Kaka have decided they must establish their own
13 employment; and

14 WHEREAS, utilities for the villages of Kaka and Ventana will be a
15 part of the financing of the project; and

16 WHEREAS, the male population of Kaka will be trained at the tile
17 plant of Mr. Antonio Kyriakis, providing the plant is a
18 free enterprise for the people of Kaka; and

19 WHEREAS, the Kaka Tile Plant will be managed and operated by the
20 people of Kaka after they have been trained and supervised
21 in the construction of the plant; and

22 WHEREAS, Mr. Kyriakis will provide a fair market for the tile with
23 no claim to their product; and

24 WHEREAS, a proposal has been submitted for the following funding for
25 a free enterprise for the people of Kaka:

26	Installation of 3-phase electricity,	
27	23 miles, PTUA estimate.....	\$161,000
28	Industrial hook-up to El Paso Gasoline.....	2,000
29	Tractor with backhoe and front end loader.....	24,000
30	Trailer with hydraulic lift.....	10,000
31	Truck (2-ton dump truck).....	15,000
32	Rock crusher and hammer mill.....	45,000

1	Physical plant, drying rooms, kilns, mixer, press and miscellaneous equipment.....	150,000
2	First year's maintenance.....	<u>10,000</u>
3	TOTAL	\$417,000



5 WHEREAS, a fair and equitable tax of the net profits will be nego-
6 tiated and paid to the Hicciwan District and the Papago
7 Tribe for the privilege of engaging in a free enterprise.

8 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that the village
9 of Kaka be permitted to enter into a free enterprise manu-
10 facturing and marketing clay floor tiles for the purpose of
11 removing the population of Kaka from the welfare rolls.

12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the population presently on the TWEP and
13 CETA payrolls remain on these payrolls until the Kaka Tile
14 Plant is producing a profit that will equal these payrolls
15 and other welfare benefits and be available to replace
16 these benefits without jeopardizing the success of the plant.

17 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on
18 the 10th day of December, 1976, at a meeting at which a quorum was
19 present with a vote of 834.0 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 0
20 absent; pursuant to authority vested in the Papago Council by
21 Section 2 (a) and (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws
22 of the Papago Tribe of Arizona, ratified by the Tribe on December 12,
1936 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937,
pursuant to Section 12 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the
Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is not subject to review by
the Secretary of the Interior.
