

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

RES. No. 14-78

1 WHEREAS; the Papago Tribe of Arizona is presently operating the following pro-
 2 grams under By-Indian services contracts with the Indian Health Services
 3 (IHS). Contract No. 249-76-0002 Community Health Representatives
 4 249-76-0029 Executive Health Staff
 5 249-75-01 Alcoholism
 6 249-76-0004 Mental Health
 7 249-76-0004 Nutrition
 8 HSM72-73-25 Disease Control
 9 249-76-0011 Elderly
 10 249-76-0013 Environmental Health
 11 249-77-0029 (Special Learning) Evaluation

12 WHEREAS, the foregoing listed programs are at present under fixed price By-Ind-
 13 ian type contract, and IHS has been mandated by the Office of Manage-
 14 ment and Budget (OMB) convert all fixed price contracts to cost reim-
 15 bursement type before the end of fiscal year 1978.

16 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that is does authorize and
 17 request the Indian Health Service to convert all the above listed con-
 18 tracts to P.L. 93-638 type of contracts at the same time they are sch-
 19 eduled to convert to cost reimbursement type contract.

20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Mr. Cecil Williams, Chairman; or in his absence Mr.
 21 Max H. Norris, Vice Chairman; or Mr. Vincent Crawford, Treasurer; is
 22 hereby authorized to negotiate and execute these contracts and any
 23 amendments thereto for the duration of contracts.

24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the duration of these contracts shall expire Sept-
 25 ember 30, 1978, unless extended by mutual agreement of both parties.

26 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Tribal Council on the
 27 7th day of April, 1978, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
 28 of 1011 for; 54.0 against; 0 not voting; and 2 absent, pursuant to authority
 29 vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a) of Article V of the Constitution
 30 and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona, ratified by the Tribe on December
 31 12, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pur-
 32 suant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution
 is not subject to review by the Secretary of Interior and is effective as of the
 date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
