5		duction on the San Xavier portion of the Reservation leased to ASARCO,				
6		from which the Tribe and allottees receive royalty income; and

8		mulas based on the net smelter return to the mining companies for				
9		minerals sold; and				
10	WHEREAS,	the net smelter return is determined by various assays, tests and pro-				
11		cedures performed by the mining companies and the smelters or buyers				
12		to which the minerals are sold; and				
13	WHEREAS,	the Bureau of Indian Affairs has offered to fund an inspector to monit				
14		these assays, tests and procedures performed at the mines and the smel				
15		ters for the Tribe.				
16	NOW, THE	REFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Papago Council requests the Bureau of				
17		Indian Affairs to fund an inspector to monitor the assays, tests and				
18		procedures performed at the Lakeshore mine, the San Xavier mine, the				
19		smelters or other buyers to which minerals are sold, and any future				
20		mines which the Tribe may choose to develop; the duties of such inspec				
21		tor shall include, but not be limited to, monitoring ore co-mingling				
22		procedures, sampling, assaying, flotation tests, metalurgical balances				
23		and processes, and any other procedures affecting royalty calculations				
24	The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 11th da
