

1 WHEREAS, the law firm of Strickland and Altaffer, general counsel  
2 for the Papago Tribe, have been requested by the Ak-Chin  
3 Indian Community to also represent them as general  
4 counsel; and

5 WHEREAS, Mr. William E. Strickland and Wilbert J. Carlyle, Chair-  
6 man of the Ak-Chin Indian Community Council, did report  
7 to the Papago Council and have requested the consent of  
8 the Council to such arrangement; and

9 WHEREAS, Mr. Strickland has advised the Papago Council that he  
10 could not foresee any conflict of interest in his firm's  
11 assumption of these additional duties except that a con-  
12 flict might arise if both the Papago Tribe and the Ak-Chin  
13 Indian Community made claim to the same waters in the  
14 Santa Cruz or other river basin if such claims are not  
15 first resolved by legislative action; and

16 WHEREAS, Mr. Strickland has advised the Papago Council that in the  
17 event such a conflict should arise, his firm would continue  
18 to represent the Papago Tribe and would obtain independent  
19 counsel to represent the Ak-Chin Indian Community in all  
20 matters related to such conflict.

21 NOW, THEREFORE, the Papago Council being fully advised in the matter,  
22 does hereby give its consent to the Ak-Chin Indian Com-  
23 munity's request that the firm of Strickland and Altaffer  
24 be permitted to represent it as general counsel, with the  
25 understanding that if a conflict should arise between the  
26 Papago Tribe and the Ak-Chin Indian Community regarding  
27 their respective claims to waters in any river basin,  
28 said firm shall continue to represent the Papago Tribe,  
29 and obtain independent counsel to represent the Ak-Chin  
30 Indian Community in all matters related to their respective  
31 conflicting claims.

32 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on

1 the 6th day of January, 1978, at a meeting at which a quorum was  
2 present with a vote of 733.5 for; 77.5 against; 254 not voting;  
3 and 0 absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Council  
4 by Section 2 (a) and (b) of Article V of the Constitution and By-  
5 laws of the Papago Tribe as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe  
6 on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior  
7 on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18,  
8 1934 (48 State. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review  
9 by the Secretary of Interior and is effective as of the date of its  
10 enactment by the Papago Council.


