

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. No. 18^d-78

1 WHEREAS, the Photogrammetry and Mapping Services of the Arizona Department of
2 Transportation, Highways Division, is developing topographic maps of
3 State Route 86 from Why to Tucson, Arizona. The control survey work
4 will include the following:

- 5 1. Establishment of geodetic traverse stations along the
6 existing highway.
- 7 2. Measurement to geodetic traverse stations from existing
8 US&GS Triangulation stations located outside the high-
9 way right of way.
- 10 3. Setting temporary panels for nerial photography.
- 11 4. Establishing horizontal and vertical positions on
12 temporary panels.
- 13 5. Provide survey ties to section corners, right of
14 way monument, and other landmarks having highway
15 significance.

16 The attached map shows the location of some of the points to which
17 these survey ties will be made.

18 WHEREAS, the Photogrammetry and Mapping Services anticipate that the work will
19 be completed by June, 1980, as frequent interruptions must be anticipated
20 and

21 WHEREAS, portions of State Route 86 traverses through the Papago Reservation
22 and

23 WHEREAS, the survey anticipated by the Arizona Department of Transportation,
24 Highway Division, Photogrammetry and Mapping Services, will be bene-
25 ficial to the Papago Tribe, and

26 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby consent
27 to the survey requested by the Department of Transportation, provided
28 that no land development be made or be anticipated by them, and that
29 the Papago Tribe be furnished a copy of the completed survey.


30 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on April 11th
31 1978, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1018 for;
32 0 against; 47 not voting; and 3 absent; pursuant to authority
vested in the Papago Council by Article IV, Section 3, and Article V, Section 2
(a) and (c) of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona

1 ratified by the Tribe of December 12, 1936, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act
2 of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date
3 of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is not subject
4 to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
