

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 20-78

1 WHEREAS, Section 104 (a) of P.L. 93-638 does authorize the granting of funds for
2 the purpose of "strengthening and improvement of Tribal Governments";
3 and

4 WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs has allocated \$262,598 of FY-78 funds for
5 such grant purposes at the Papago Reservation; and

6 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe does have need to strengthen and develop its Tribal
7 government and management.


8 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Papago Council does request the Bureau
9 of Indian Affairs to grant funds to the Papago Tribe in the amount of
10 at least \$262,598.

11 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that such funds shall be used for the development and im-
12 provement of Tribal government according to the budget and work program
13 herein attached.

14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Mr. Cecil Williams, Chairman, or in his absence, Mr.
15 Max H. Norris, Vice Chairman, or Mr. Vincent Crawford, Treasurer are
16 hereby authorized to negotiate and sign whatever grant documents are
17 required and, further, to negotiate and sign amendments and extensions
18 to such grant.

19 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 26th day
20 of April, 1978, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1011
21 for; 54 against 0 not voting; and 1 absent, pursuant to authority vested in
22 the Papago Council by Section 2 (d) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws
23 of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December
12, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pur-
suant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution
is not subject to review by the Secretary of Interior and is effective as of the
date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
