10	Mary Jane Narcho as Secretary of the Papgo Council.

13 14 15 16	The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 5th. day of May , 1978, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 993.5 for; 0 against; 71.5 not voting; and 3 absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Council by Section 4 of Article III and Section 2 (e) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
