

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

Resolution No. 24-78

1 WHEREAS, the Maricopa County C.E.T.A. Program has approximately \$260,163.00 for
2 the San Lucy Community Complex with 15% being used for administration
3 cost and 85% used for public service employment training; and

4 WHEREAS, based on consultants studies and informatin it has been determind
5 that an additional \$55,049.00 is needed to complete the project; a
6 proposed plan budget is attached hereto and made a part hereof; and

7 WHEREAS, the San Lucy District Council has been unsuccessful in its attempts to
8 acquire the necessary additional funding; and

9 WHEREAS, the San Lucy District Council has determined that the need for the
10 additional funding is critical to enable this community complex to serve
11 the residents of San Lucy; and

12 WHEREAS, the only source of funding available for this project known to the San
13 Lucy District is funds consisting of one-half of the Tribal mining income
14 which has been set aside in a special account as District funds and as
15 yet undistributed; and

16 WHEREAS, the San Lucy District Council believes that its pro-rated share of said
17 existing funds, under any system the Tribal Council should adopt in the
18 future, would exceed the \$55,049.00 needed to complete the San Lucy
19 Community Complex, and that the use of these funds for the purposes
20 stated herein would be in the best interest of the Papago people resid-
21 ing in San Lucy District.

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Papago Tribal Council does hereby authorize
23 the withdrawal of \$55,049.00 from the District mining income account to
24 be delivered to the San Lucy District Council who shall be responsible in
25 the disbursement of said funds in accordance with the proposed plan
26 budget attached hereto and made a part hereof.

27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman or Vice-Chairman shall take all necessary
28 steps to accomplish the purposes of this resolution.

1 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the May
2 day of 5, 1978, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
3 of 141 for; 520 against; 404 not voting; and 3 absent,
4 pursuant to the authority vested in the Council by Section 3 of Article IV and
5 Section 3 (a) (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago
6 Tribe as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved
7 by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of
8 the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the
9 date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject
10 to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
