

RESOLUTION OF THE PĀPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

RES. No. 25-78

1 WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs have funds available at the Papago Agency  
 2 in the sum of \$21,002; and  
 3 WHEREAS, this fund is for the purpose of Law Enforcement and specifically for  
 4 the completion of the Law Enforcement Improvement Plan Workbook II; and  
 5 WHEREAS, under previous arrangements Workbook I has been completed by Eisenburg  
 6 and Associates, Inc. with satisfaction; and  
 7 WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the Papago Tribal Law Enforcement Depart-  
 8 ment that this contract and scope of work be completed in order to  
 9 strengthen and improve Law & Order services.  
 10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Papago Council of Arizona authorize the  
 11 Chairman or in his absence the Vice-Chairman and/or Treasurer to negotiate  
 12 a contract with the Bureau of Indian Affairs under the P.L. 93-638  
 13 Indian Self-Determination Act for the purpose of completing Workbook II  
 14 as prescribed in the proposal submitted by the Planning Department.  
 15 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on May 24, 1978,  
 16 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1011 for; 54.0 against;  
 17 0 not voting; and 1 absent; pursuant to authority vested in the Papago  
 18 Council by Section 2 (a) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the  
 19 Papago Tribe, as amended, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and appro-  
 20 ved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16  
 21 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to  
 22 review by the Secretary of the Interior.
