

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

RES. No. 29-78

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe has a continued need for a Highway Safety Program to  
2 provide expert advice and assistance in minimizing the high automobile  
3 accident fatalities and injuries and property damage on the Papago  
4 Reservation roads; and

5 WHEREAS, the Papago Council wishes to continue to accept the responsibility for  
6 Tribal participation in a Highway Safety Program and to commit services  
7 of other Tribal Programs, the Bureau of Indian Affairs and the State  
8 of Arizona; and

9 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe is now able to itself administer and provide such  
10 services; and

11 WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs has funds appropriated from the Department  
12 of Transportation to provide grants to Tribes for such services during  
13 Fiscal Year 1978.

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby request  
15 a grant/contract with the Bureau of Indian Affairs to provide a general  
16 Highway Safety Program in accordance with the attached Tribal staffing  
17 and funding requests submitted in accordance with the Department of  
18 Transportation Annual Work Program application requirements;

19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Mr. Cecil Williams, Chairman, or in his absence,  
20 the Vice Chairman or Treasurer, hereby be authorized to negotiate and  
21 execute the grant/contract or amendments thereto for the duration of  
22 the contract.

23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this grant/contract shall begin on October 1, 1978  
24 and end September 30, 1979 and may be extended or revised by mutual  
25 agreement of both parties.

26 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on 24 day of  
27 May 1978, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 993.5 for;  
28 0 against; 71.5 not voting; and 1 absent, pursuant to authority  
29 vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a) of Article V of the Constitution  
30 and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona ratified by the Tribe on December 12,  
31 1936 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant  
32 to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is  
not subject to review by the Secretary of Interior.
