12	ments at the earliest possible date to provide such services to the							
13	Papago Reservation by means of staff technician(s) stationed on the							
14	Reservation.

16	of June ,1978, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of							
17	ц85 for; 260 against; 320 not voting; and 1 absent, purusant to							
18	the authority vested in the Council by Section 2 (a) of Article V of the Con-							
19	stitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe as amended, ratified by the Papago							
20	Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on							
21	January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.							
22	984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of Interior and							
23	is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
