

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

Res. No. 30-78

1 WHEREAS, the Department of Agriculture has, through the Soil Conservation Ser-
2 vice, rendered valuable technical assistance to land owners in natural
3 resource conservation districts; and

4 WHEREAS, the Department of Agriculture proposes to expand these services through
5 the Bureau of Soil Conservation to include Indian lands; and

6 WHEREAS, the Papago Reservation is a part of the Pima Natural Resource District
7 and, as such, entitled to these services.

8 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it recognizes the
9 benefits of the technical services rendered by the Department of Agri-
10 culture to owners of land in natural resource conservation districts,
11 and it does hereby request the Department of Agriculture to make arrange-
12 ments at the earliest possible date to provide such services to the
13 Papago Reservation by means of staff technician(s) stationed on the
14 Reservation.

15 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 2 day
16 of June, 1978, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
17 485 for; 260 against; 320 not voting; and 1 absent, pursuant to
18 the authority vested in the Council by Section 2 (a) of Article V of the Con-
19 stitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe as amended, ratified by the Papago
20 Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on
21 January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.
22 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of Interior and
23 is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
