1 WHEREAS, it is the policy of this locality to eliminate substandard and other 2 inadequate housing to prevent the spread of slums and blight, and to 3 realize as soon as feasiable the goal of a decent home in a suitable 4 living environment for all of its citizens; and 5 WHEREAS, under the provisions of the United States Housing Act of 1937, as 6 amended, by the United States of America, acting through the Secretary 7 of Housing and Urban Development (herein called the "Government"), is 8 authorized to provide financial assistance to local public housing 9 agencies for undertaking and carrying out preliminary planning of 10 Mutual Help housing projects that will assist in meeting this goal, and the Act provides that there shall be local determination need for Mutual 11 WHEREAS, 12 Help housing to meet needs not being adequately met by private enter-13 prise and that the Government shall not make any contract with a publid 14 housing agency for preliminary loans for surveys and planning in respect 15 to any Mutual Help housing projects unless the government body of the 16 locality involved has by resolution approved the application of the 17 public housing agency for such preliminary loan; and 18 WHEREAS, the Papago Housing Authority (herein called the "Local Authority") is 19 a public housing agency and is applying to the Government for a 20 preliminary loan to cover the costs of surveys and planning in 21 connection with the development of Mutual Help housing; 22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Tribal Council of the Papago Tribe 23 of Arizona as follows: 24 That there exists in the Papago Tribe of Arizona a need for much 25 Mutual Help housing which is not being met by private enterprise; 26 That the application of the local Authority to the Government for 27 a preliminary loan in an amount not to exceed \$25,000 for surveys 28 and planning in connection with Mutual Help housing projects of not 29 to exceed approximately (50) fifty dwelling units is hereby approved.
