

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe sees the need to provide transportation
2 for Papago students attending Off-Reservation Boarding
3 Schools and also provide transportation for summer school
4 programs,

5 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe requests to provide for transportation
6 of all Off-Reservation Boarding School students to all
7 schools beginning Dec. '78 and January 1979 and,

8 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe requests all necessary transportation
9 for summer program operations and Off-Reservation Board-
10 ing School travel including charter buses, airfare,
11 chaperones including travel and per diem costs. Each
12 Phoenix Area Off-Reservation Boarding School will assume
13 the cost of returning students home at the close of
14 school and,

15 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe will provide Off-Reservation Boarding
16 School travel to the following school locations:

17 Phoenix Indian School
18 Inter-Mountain Indian School
19 Stewart Indian School
20 Sherman Indian School

21 emergency situations will be considered with the follow-
22 ing schools:

23 Southwestern Indian Polytechnic Institute
24 Chilocco Indian School
25 Haskell Indian Junior College
26 Institute of American Indian Arts

27 otherwise these students are normally recipients of
28 Higher Education Grants/Scholarships and,

29 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Papago Tribal Council
30 approves and endorses to contract from the Bureau of Indian Affairs
31 student transportation for summer programs and all Off-Reservation
32 Boarding Schools beginning December, 1978 and thereafter and be
placed in two separate line items within the Community Education
Contract currently in effect.

1 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council July 7, 1978
2 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 926.5 for; 67
3 against; 71.5 not voting; and 2 absent, pursuant to the authority
4 vested in the Papago Council by Section 1, Article V; and Section 3 (a) of
5 Article VIII of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe, as amended,
6 ratified by the Papago Tribe of December 12, 1936, and approved by the
7 Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of
8 the Act of June 18, 1934. Said Resolution is effective as of the date of
9 its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is not subject to
10 review by the Secretary of the Interior.
