

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

RES. NO. 37-78

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe of Arizona is presently operating the following
2 programs under FY-78 P.L. 93-638 service contracts with the Bureau
3 of Indian Affairs:

- 4 - Papago Children's Home
- 5 - Papago Agricultural Services
- 6 - Papago Court
- 7 - Papago Enrollment
- 8 - Papago JOM Education
- 9 - Papago Halfway House
- 10 - Papago Tribal Work Experience Program (T.W.E.P.)
- 11 - Papago Education Office (Community Education); and

12 WHEREAS, such tribal operations have been successful and beneficial to the
13 Papago Tribe and its people; and

14 WHEREAS, 25 CFR Sec. 271.20 of the Federal Regulations requires that all
15 proposals to recontract under P.L. 93-638 be submitted to the
16 Tribal Council for approval at least 120 days prior to the contract
17 termination; and

18 WHEREAS, the Papago Council does desire to recontract for provision of these
19 services during FY-79.

20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does authorize
21 and request the Bureau of Indian Affairs to contract with the
22 Papago Tribe under P.L. 93-638 regulations and procedures for the
23 provision of services titled:

- 24 - Papago Children's Home
- 25 - Papago Agricultural Services
- 26 - Papago Court
- 27 - Papago Enrollment
- 28 - Papago JOM Education
- 29 - Papago Halfway House
- 30 - Papago Tribal Work Experience Program (T.W.E.P.)
- 31 - Papago Education Office (Community Education)



BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the duration of these contracts shall be from October 1, 1978 to September 30, 1979, but may be extended by mutual agreement of both parties.


The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 7 day of July 1978, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1065 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 2 absent, pursuant to authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on Jnauary 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
