

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. No. 3-78


1 WHEREAS, the Papago Office of CETA Programs has worked out an arran-  
2 gement with the Maricopa County Board of Supervisors where-  
3 by Maricopa County will provide public service employment  
4 under Title II and VI of the Comprehensive Employment and  
5 Training Act of 1973, as amended, to residents of the Gila  
6 Bend District; and

7 WHEREAS, it is necessary for the Papago Tribe to enter into Inter-  
8 governmental Agreement (s) with the Maricopa County Board  
9 of Supervisors in order to obtain public service employment  
10 for the residents of the Gila Bend District.

11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does  
12 hereby authorize the Chairman of the Papago Tribe to enter  
13 into and execute Intergovernmental Agreement(s) with the  
14 Maricopa County Board of Supervisors on behalf of the  
15 Papago Tribe providing for public service employment for  
16 members of the Gila Bend District pursuant to the Compre-  
17 hensive Employment and Training Act of 1973, as amended.

18 The Foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on  
19 the 3rd day of February, 1978, at a meeting at which a quorum was  
20 present with a vote of 1047.5 for;        against; 17.5 not voting;  
21 and 1 absent; pursuant to authority vested in the Council by Sec-  
22 tion 2 (a) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the  
23 Papago Tribe, as amended, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936  
24 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937,  
25 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984)  
26 Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of Inter-  
27 ior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago  
28 Council
