

RESOLUTION OF THE SAN LUCY DISTRICT COUNCIL

RES. NO. 38-78

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe did on June 2, 1978, pass an Ordinance which
 2 authorize and direct the allocation of \$50,000.00, from the
 3 Districts' mining account to the District Councils of the eleven
 4 Districts of the Papago Reservation; and
 5 WHEREAS, these allocated funds can be used by the District for multi-
 6 pruposes, that will benefit the District and its community;
 7 and
 8 WHEREAS, the San Lucy District Council in a meeting held on June 30, 1978,
 9 did discuss on how to use these alloacted funds and made out a
 10 proposal.
 11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the San Lucy District Council, by this
 12 resolution, hereby request the Papago Tribal Council to authorize
 13 the withdrawal of \$50,000.00 from the Districts' allocated
 14 account to be delivered to the San Lucy District Council who
 15 shall use said funds in accordance with proposed plan budget
 16 attached hereto.
 17 BE IT FUTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman or Vice-Chairman shall
 18 take all necessary steps to accomplish the purposes of this
 19 resolution.

20 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the
 21 7 day of July, 1978, at a meeting at which a quorum was present
 22 with a vote of 1065.0 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 2
 23 absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Council by Section 2
 24 of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe as amended
 25 ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the
 26 Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of
 27 the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject
 28 to review by the Secretary of Interior and is effective as of the date of
 29 its enactment by the Papago Council.
