WHEREAS, the San Xavier District Council has, by Resolution No. 02-78, dated March 28, 1978, requested the Bureau of Indian Affairs to provide certain technical and professional services available to the Bureau to serve new projects and programs undertaken by the San Xavier District related to Farming, Education, Industrial Development and Livestock operation; and

WHEREAS, it is to the benefit of the Papago people that such services be provided by the Bureau of Indian Affairs.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it supports the San Xavier District Council in its request for such technical and professional services, and hereby requests the Bureau of Indian Affairs to provide such services as requested by the San Xavier District Council and as agreed upon by said Council and the Bureau of Indian Affairs.


The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 7 day of July, 1978, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 930.5 for; 0 against; 134.5 not voting; and 3 absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Council by Section 2 of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
