NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Tribal Council that the jurisdiction of the Papago Tribal Court in all matters relating to guardianships of minor children and incapacitated persons is hereby expressly affirmed and ratified.

Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
