ment of a permanent Tribal water resource management office in order to coordinate water resource development; to defend, protect and conserve existing Papago water resources; and to seek additional water resources need for Papago development;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council does hereby authorize the preparation and submission to E.P.A. of a formal request for designation of the Papago Reservation as an independent water quality planning area and of an application for a section 208 grant to support the continuing water quality planning effort;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council desires to have a 12 comprehensive Tribal water quality ordinance and does 13 direct the 208 Project to prepare such and ordinance 14 for Council consideration, said proposal to include 15 standards for water protection, conservation and 16 development and specific priorities for management action, and to be presented to the Council within the 18 next 60 days. 19

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council 20 day of August, 1978, at a meeting at which a on the 4 quorum was present with a vote of <u>1065.0</u> for; <u>0</u> against; <u>0</u> not voting; and <u>2</u> absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Council by Sections (a), (e) and (m) of Article II of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe as amend-ed, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary 21 22 23 24 of Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment 25 by the Papago Council. 26
