- WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe has taken the initiative in establishing negotiations between the principal water user of
 Eastern Pima County in the hope of reaching a settlement of such suit; and
- WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA) is the federal agency primarily responsible for the administration of Indian property and has responsibility for programs directed toward the protection, development and use of Indian resources; and
- WHEREAS, the U. S. Corps of Engineers (CORPS) is recognized as a scientific and technical authority on matters pertaining to Eastern Pima County regional water needs and alternative sources.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby request technical assistance from the BIA and the CORPS to determine how to supply water to the San Xavier Reservation in a quantity sufficient to satisfy its Winters water rights.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 4 day of August, 1978, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1065.0for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 0 absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Council by Section 2 (a) and (b) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
