

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL  
(Requesting technical assistance )  
(from BIA and Corps of Engineers )  
(to determine how to supply water)  
(to San Xavier Reservation )

RES. NO. 44-78

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe is the plaintiff in a law suit in  
2 which it is seeking, inter alia, a Winters rights  
3 determination in the waters of the San Xavier Reserva-  
4 tion; and

5 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe has taken the initiative in establish-  
6 ing negotiations between the principal water user of  
7 Eastern Pima County in the hope of reaching a settle-  
8 ment of such suit; and


9 WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA) is the federal  
10 agency primarily responsible for the administration  
11 of Indian property and has responsibility for programs  
12 directed toward the protection, development and use  
13 of Indian resources; and

14 WHEREAS, the U. S. Corps of Engineers (CORPS) is recognized as  
15 a scientific and technical authority on matters per-  
16 taining to Eastern Pima County regional water needs  
17 and alternative sources.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it  
19 does hereby request technical assistance from the BIA  
20 and the CORPS to determine how to supply water to the  
21 San Xavier Reservation in a quantity sufficient to  
22 satisfy its Winters water rights.

23 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council  
24 on the 4 day of August, 1978, at a meeting at which a  
25 quorum was present with a vote of 1065.0 for; 0 against;  
26 0 not voting; and 0 absent, pursuant to the authority  
27 vested in the Council by Section 2 (a) and (b) of Article V  
28 of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe as amended,  
29 ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved  
30 by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant  
31 to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).  
32 Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of  
Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by  
the Papago Council.
