## RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL (Adopting an interim 1979 Budget)

RES. NO.53--78

- WHEREAS, a substantial portion of the Tribe's income needed to support its budgeted expenses comes from royalties paid by the Hecla Mining Company; and
- WHEREAS, the Papago Council has been advised that the Hecla Mining Company is in serious financial difficulty and may have to divest itself of the Lakeshore Mine on the Papago Reservation; and
- WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe's fiscal year starts October 1 and it would be imprudent to adopt a budget for the 1979 fiscal year which assumes uninterrupted royalty payments by the Hecla Mining Company; and
- WHEREAS, the Papago Council has been advised that the Hecla Mining Company is presently receiving bids for the sale of the Lakeshore Mine, and that the Council should know within the next three months whether there will be a successor to the Hecla Mining Company capable of continuing its commitments and making royalty payments to the Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, the Papago Council believes that it is in the best interests of the Papago Tribe to defer the adoption of a final 1979 budget until it can be determined that the royalties due the Tribe under the terms of its agreement with the Hecla Mining Company will eventually be forthcoming during the 1979 fiscal year; and
- WHEREAS, the Papago Council has in the past year met without compensation because of lack of budgeted funds; and
- WHEREAS, the Council has reviewed the Treasurer's estimate of income and expenses for the next three months, and it appears therefrom that there will be sufficient funds to make the payments due to members of the Papago Council for past uncompensated meetings;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby adopt an interim 1979 budget for the period of October 1, 1978, to January 1, 1979, of (a) one-quarter (1/4) of the 1978 annual budget, not including costs for capital equipment, plus (b) any unused portions of such budget for capital equipment; provided, however, that the portion of such interim budget attributable to Tribal Administration be increased by \$12,000.00 in order to permit payment to members of the Papago Council of past unpaid Council attendance compensation.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 11th day of October, 1978, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 962 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 4 absent, pursuant to authority vested in the Council by Section 3 (a) and (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to review by the Secretary of Interior.
