

RESOLUTION OF PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
(Authorizing Valley National Bank)
(loan for CETA Programs)

RES. NO. 59-78

WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe, as a prime sponsor, operates the Papago-CETA Programs on the Papago Reservation under the Comprehensive Employment and Training Act of 1973, as amended; and

WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe has been advised by the Department of Labor that, though the 1979 FY authorization for continuance of CETA Programs has passed Congress, appropriations necessary to make payments due on existing payrolls under the CETA Programs have not been authorized but that such funds will be available shortly; and

WHEREAS, the Papago-CETA Programs have an outstanding payroll in excess of \$87,000.00, and it is necessary to borrow funds to meet this and probably the next payroll period.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby authorize and approve the securing of a loan up to the amount of \$200,000.00 from the Valley National Bank of Arizona, Downtown office, Tucson, Arizona, to fund the Papago-CETA Programs; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Cecil Williams, the Chairman, or Max Norris, Vice-Chairman, and Mary Jane Narcho, Secretary of the Papago Tribal Council are hereby authorized to sign and execute a promissory note, or notes, and such other documents as may be necessary to obtain such loan.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 1ST day of December, 1978, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 932 for; 0 against; 133 not voting; and 0 absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Council by Section 2 (f) and (h) and Section 3 (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.


