

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
(Authorizing operation of Papago-CETA
Program and ratifying actions of the
Chairman relative thereto)

RES. NO. 60-78

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe has in the past developed and operated the CETA
2 Program on the Papago Reservation, and is presently operating such
3 Program; and


4 WHEREAS, the action or Resolution of the Papago Council authorizing such
5 CETA Program has been lost or misplaced; and

6 WHEREAS, the Papago-CETA Program is of great value to the Papago people, and
7 it is essential to continue such Program.


8 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby
9 authorize the development, operation and continuance of the Papago-
10 CETA Program, and that it does hereby authorize and direct the
11 Chairman or Vice Chairman of the Papago Council to execute any
12 contract, agreement or document with the Federal or State govern-
13 ments, or any departments, agencies or subdivisions thereof, and
14 with any private or public corporations or organizations, necessary
15 or incidental to the development, operation or continuance of such
16 Program on the Papago Reservation, hereby ratifying any act or acts
17 of the Chairman or Vice Chairman of the Papago Council in executing
18 such contract, agreement or document in the past.


19 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 3rd day
20 of November, 1978, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
21 1015.5 for; 49.5 against; 0 not voting; and 0 absent, pursuant to
22 the authority vested in the Council by Section 2 (a) (e) and (h) of Article V
23 of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe as amended, ratified by
24 the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the
Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18,
1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary
of Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago
Council.
