

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 61-78

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe is desirous of carrying out a Juvenile Justice
2 Program for its youth; and
3 WHEREAS, the Papago Juvenile Detention Officer project has been identified
4 as a priority in the Juvenile Justice Program.
5 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Papago Tribe is fully supportive
6 and endorses the Juvenile Detention Officer Project as a means of
7 developing and improving the quality of juvenile justice on the
8 Papago Reservation.
9 LET IT ALSO BE RESOLVED, that the Papago Tribe, through the Administration,
10 will use the funds only for the purpose as stated.
11 LET IT BE FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Papago Tribe request a waiver of any
12 required cash match and will provide any necessary documents as
13 needed by the State Justice Planning Agency.
14 LET IT FINALLY BE RESOLVED, that the Chairman, or his designee, is hereby
15 authorized to carry out the responsibility of providing documents,
16 negotiating terms, and signing all necessary papers from
17 application through completion of project funds.

18 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 1st
19 day of December, 1978, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a
20 vote of 1065.0 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 0 absent,
21 pursuant to authority vested in the Papago Council by Sections 2 (a) and
22 (m) and 3 (h) and (l) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the
23 Papago Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by
the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16
of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective
as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency
and is subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.


