

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL
(Authorizing appropriation and P. L. 93-638
Contract for Lakeshore Mine)

- WHEREAS, The Papago Tribe did by an Agreement dated October 31, 1978 acquire an option to purchase certain removable mining equipment at the Lakeshore Mine from the Hecla Mining Company (Hecla) and the El Paso Natural Gas Company (El Paso) for an option period terminating three months from the date of the Agreement, unless within two months from such date the Tribe deposits \$200,000, in addition to an original \$300,000 deposit, to cover the cost of upkeep, maintenance and preservation of the Lakeshore Mine; and
- WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 55-78, the Papago Council did authorize and direct its officers, agents and attorneys to seek funds from the Department of Interior and other sources to pay the cost of such upkeep, maintenance and preservation of the mine, and did appropriate up to \$300,000 from the mining royalty account allocated to the eleven Districts of the Papago Reservation to supplement the funds acquired from such sources in order to pay for the cost of such upkeep, maintenance and preservation of the mine; and
- WHEREAS, the Department of Interior has allocated \$300,000 to the Papago Tribe for the purpose of paying such cost and the Papago Tribe has made application for such funds pursuant to P. L. 93-638; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe's application for such funds cannot be processed in time to meet the option criteria of the Agreement, and the Tribe did advance \$300,000 from the mining royalty account allocated to the eleven Districts in order to receive the first three month option period, and it will be necessary for the Tribe to advance an additional \$200,000 from such mining royalty account to receive the additional two month option period pending the processing and approval of the Tribe's application pursuant to P. L. 93-638 for the \$300,000 allocated for such purpose by the Department of Interior to the Tribe.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby authorize, and directs the Chairman or Vice-Chairman and any other appropriate officers of the Papago Council, to execute a P. L. 93-638 contract for the purpose of obtaining funds to pay or reimburse the Tribe for the cost of upkeep, maintenance and preservation of the Lakeshore Mine pursuant to the terms of the Tribe's Agreement with Hecla and El Paso.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that it does hereby appropriate an additional \$200,000 from the mining royalty account allocated to the eleven Districts of the Papago Reservation in order to pay for the cost of upkeep, maintenance and preservation of the Lakeshore Mine pursuant to the terms of the Tribe's Agreement with Hecla and El Paso.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that upon receipt, pursuant to P. L. 93-638, from the Department of Interior of the \$300,000 allocated by it to the Tribe for the purpose hereinabove referred to, such funds be allocated to, and deposited into the mining royalty account allocated to the eleven Districts of the Papago Reservation.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 28th day of December, 1978, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 939.5 for; 71.5 against; 54.0 not voting; and 2 absent, pursuant to authority vested in the Council by Section

3 (a) and (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to review by the Secretary of Interior.
