

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Housing Authority has submitted plans for the construction
2 of HUD homes in the Vaya Chin Village of the HICKIWAN District, which
3 plans would place those homes into standard sub-division densities; and

4 WHEREAS, the residents of Vaya Chin are accustomed to living in a less dense en-
5 vironment and have expressed the wish that the proposed HUD homes be
6 built upon scattered sites; and


7 WHEREAS, the HICKIWAN District Council has, by Resolution dated November 16, 1977,
8 supported the request of the residents of Vaya Chin Village; and

9 WHEREAS, under Section 3 (a) of Article VIII of the Constitution of the Papago
10 Tribe, authority to make assignments of land for beneficial use and
11 occupancy is placed in the District Councils, and consequently their
12 authority in all matters affecting placement of housing in their res-
13 pective Districts is final and conclusive.


14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it supports the action
15 of the HICKIWAN District Council in support of the request of the re-
16 sidents of Vaya Chin Village that the proposed construction of HUD
17 homes be upon scattered, rather than subdivision sites, and directs
18 the Papago Housing Authority to do everything within its power to facil-
19 itate this request of the residents of Vaya Chin Village.

20 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 10th day
21 of March, 1978, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
22 1047.5 for; 0 against; 17.5 not voting; and 0 absent, pursuant to the authority
23 vested in the Council by Sections 2 (a) and (e) of Article V of the Constitution
24 and By-laws of the Papago Tribe as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on Dec-
ember 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937,
pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said
Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of Interior and is effective
as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.

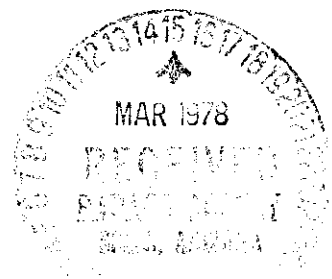
