NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby approve the construction of a photovoltaic power systems for the village of Schuchuli in accordance with the terms and conditions of the Memorandum of Understanding and Implementation Plan (Agreements), and does hereby authorize and direct the Chairman or Vice-Chairman of the Papago Council

that, by execution thereof, the Papago Tribe be in no way committed to use of its general funds to pay for the cost of procurement, fabrication or installation of any materials or services set forth therein, and that, upon execution thereof, a copy of this Resolution be attached thereto.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman and Vice-Chairman of the Papago Council are hereby authorized and directed to do everything necessary to implement the purposes of this Resolution, including the negotiation and execution on behalf of the Papago Tribe of any request, application or

contract for funds from any Federal or other sources to finance the
