

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

RES. No 9-78

1 WHEREAS, it is the policy of this locality to eliminate substandard and other
2 inadequate housing to prevent the spread of slums and blight, and to
3 realize as soon as feasible the goal of a decent home in a suitable
4 living environment for all of its citizens; and

5 WHEREAS, under the provisions of the United States Housing Act of 1937, as amend-
6 ed, the United States of America, acting through the Secretary of
7 Housing and Urban Development (herein called the "Government"), is au-
8 thorized to provide financial assistance to local public housing agen-
9 cies for undertaking and carrying out preliminary planning of Mutual
10 Help housing projects that will assist in meeting this goal; and

11 WHEREAS, the Act provides that there shall be local determination need for Mutual
12 Help housing to meet needs not being adequately met by private enter-
13 prise and that the Government shall not make any contract with a public
14 housing agency for preliminary loans for surveys and planning in re-
15 spect to any Mutual Help housing projects unless the government body of
16 the locality involved has by resolution approved the application of
17 the public housing agency for such preliminary loan; and

18 WHEREAS, the Papago Housing Authority (herein called the "Local Authority")
19 is a public housing agency and is applying to the Government for a
20 preliminary loan to cover the costs of surveys and planning in connec-
21 tion with the development of Mutual Help housing;

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Tribal Council of the Papago Tribe
23 of Arizona as follows:

- 24 1. That there exists in the Papago Tribe of Arizona a need for much
25 Mutual Help housing which is not being met by private enterprise;
- 26 2. That the application of the local Authority to the Government for
27 a preliminary loan in an amount not to exceed \$41,500.00 for surveys and planning
28 in connection with Mutual Help housing projects of not to exceed approximately
29 Eighty Two (82) dwelling units is hereby approved.


1 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 10th
2 day of March, 1978, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
3 1065 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 0 absent, pursuant to the
4 authority vested in the Council by Section 2 (a) and (h) of Article V of the
5 Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe as amended, ratified by the Papago
6 Tribe on December 12, 1936, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934
7 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of the
8 Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
