

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

RESOLUTION NO. 1-80

1 WHEREAS, The Farmers Home Administration (Fm.H.A.) Washington, D.C. is provid-
2 ing Planning Grant to Rural Communities and Indian Reservations to
3 plan self help housing programs, and;

4 WHEREAS, Farmers Home Administration has allocated \$47,810.00 for the Papago
5 Tribe in 1979 to plan with villages, districts and General Council
6 a self help housing program. These funds were matched by in-kind
7 contributions and/or funds of the Papago Tribe worth \$15,937.00 for a
8 total of \$63,747.00 for 12 months.

9 WHEREAS, The Planning Department is requesting for a continuation of funding
10 or another year, and;

11 WHEREAS, Farmers Home Administration allocated \$42,000.00 for the Papago Tribe
12 these funds would be matched by in-kind contributions of the Papago
13 Tribe worth \$14,000.00 for a total of \$56,000.00 for 12 months.

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the Papago Council hereby approves and supports
15 the efforts of the Planning Department.

16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Mr. Max H. Norris, Chairman or in his absence, the
17 Vice Chairman, Mr. Enos J. Francisco, Jr., is hereby authorized to
18 execute the Fm.H.A. grant/contract or any amendments, other documents,
19 instruments, or agreements in relation thereto.

20 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 9th
21 day of January, 1980, at a meeting at which a quorum was presented with a vote
22 of 622.5 for; 175 against; 167.5 not voting; 0 absent; pursuant to the
23 authority vested in the Council by Section 2 (a) and (d) of Article V of the
24 constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe as amended ratified by the Papago
25 Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on
January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.
984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the
Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is not subject to review by the
Secretary of the Interior.
