13	Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe as amended, ratifed by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of Interior on							
14	January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the							
15	Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to review by the Secretary of Interior.
