

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL
(Asking for removal of Superintendent)

RES. NO. 9-80

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Council has reviewed the acts and performance of the Papago
2 Indian Agency Office and of the Superintendent of the Agency; and

3 WHEREAS, the Papago Council has concluded that said Agency is being incom-
4 petently managed, and has been and remains insensitive to the needs
5 of the Papago Tribe and its people,

6 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby re-
7 commend to the Commissioner of Indian Affairs and the Secretary of the Interior
8 that Richard T. Christman, Superintendent of the Papago Indian Agency be re-
9 moved from such office and assigned to duties off of the Papago Reservation.

10 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 13th
11 day of February, 1980, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
12 of 493 for; 69 against; 403 not voting; and 1 absent, pursuant to the authority
13 vested in the Council by Section 3 (f) of Article V of the Constitution and By-
14 Laws of the Papago Tribe as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December
12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937,
pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Reso-
lution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of
the Papago Agency and is subject to review by the Secretary of Interior.
