

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
(Request to B.I.A. Social Services)

RES. NO. 107-80

1 WHEREAS, in Section 18 (E) of the Children's Code of the Papago Tribe it is
2 provided that "A child shall not be held in detention awaiting place-
3 ment for more than 30 days after the entry of the dispositional
4 order;" and


5 WHEREAS, the Children's Court has often been unable to place children in proper
6 facilities within the 30 days mandated by the Code because the Social
7 Services of the Sells B.I.A. Agency has failed to provide such
8 facilities; and

9 WHEREAS, the Papago Council is seriously concerned by the B.I.A.'s failure to
10 promptly to place children subject to a dispositional order in proper
11 facilities.


12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby strongly
13 urge and request the Social Services of the Sells B.I.A. Agency promptly
14 to make placements of children subject to a dispositional order, to the
15 end that such children are placed in proper facilities with a minimum
16 of social and educational dislocation and in time to meet the criteria
17 set out in the Children's Code.

18 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 8th
19 day of October, 1980, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
20 965. for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 0 absent, pursuant to
21 the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a) and (e) of Article
22 V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended,
23 ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary
of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June
18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the
Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by
the Papago Council.
