

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
(Draft Constitution to the people)
(and on the Ballot in May, 1981)

RES. NO. 113-80

1 WHEREAS, the Constitution Committee has submitted a proposed Constitution of
2 the Papago Nation dated September 11, 1980, revised October 8, 1980,
3 to the Papago Council; and

4 WHEREAS, the Committee has advised the Council of a planned joint meeting by
5 the Committee with the Enrollment Committee to review the constitu-
6 tional definition for membership and that it would be prepared to
7 submit a final draft of the Constitution to the Council at its next
8 meeting in November; and

9 WHEREAS, the Papago Council has determined that it is important that the draft
10 of the Constitution be taken forthwith to the people of the various
11 Districts and be submitted to a vote of the people at a Secretarial
12 election which should coincide with the Papago Tribe's next general
13 election scheduled in May, 1981.

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that the proposed
15 Constitution with its Papago translation be taken by the Constitution
16 Committee to public meetings of the Districts and that it be prepared
17 for submission to a Secretarial election to coincide with the Papago
18 Tribe's general election scheduled in May, 1981.

19 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 9th
20 day of October, 1980, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
21 of 425.5 for; 421.5 against; 79.0 not voting; and 39.0 absent, pursuant
22 to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (F) of Article V
23 of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended,
24 ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the
25 Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the
26 Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review
27 by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its
28 enactment by the Papago Council.
