

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL
(Authorizing distribution of FY
1980 Revenue Sharing Funds)

RES. NO. 11-80

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe is entitled to receive \$248,020.00 of Federal Revenue
2 Sharing funds; and

3 WHEREAS, the Papago Council has conducted two public hearings to determine the
4 greatest needs of the Papago people for the use of such funds,

5 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that, in accordance with
6 priorities expressed at the public hearings had for such purpose, it
7 is hereby directed that distribution of FY 1980 federal Revenue
8 Sharing funds be made as follows:

9 1. Budget for Office of Revenue Sharing
10 Coordinator \$ 40,886.00

11 2. Papago Special Learning 7,114.00

12 3. Distribution to the eleven (11) districts upon
13 approval by this Council of their respective
14 Revenue Sharing requests based on their respective
15 resident populations and based further on the
qualifying priorities expressed at the Public
Hearings and set out, listed by district, in the
attached schedule of Revenue Sharing Public
Hearings requests, in the following amounts:

23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Papago Revenue Sharing Coordinator obtain such
24 requests from the various District Councils and integrate them into
25 an overall Tribal Revenue Sharing Budget, listed by qualifying tribal
26 and district priorities, for further consideration and action by this
27 Council.

28 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the FY 1980 budget of the Papago Tribe is hereby
29 amended to reflect the intent and directions of the foregoing Resolu-
30 tion by the elimination therefrom of the \$100,000.00 debt service item
31 originally directed to be funded from Federal Revenue Sharing funds.

1 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 19th.
2 day of February, 1980, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with
3 a vote of 847.5 for; 76 against; 41.5 not voting; and 1
4 absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Council by Section 2 (a), (d)
5 and (m) and Section 3 (a) and (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws
6 of the Papago Tribe as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12,
7 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pur-
8 suant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution
9 is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago
10 Agency and is subject to review by the Secretary of Interior.
