

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
(Directing Chairman of Papago Farming
Authority to make further report on
B.I.A. audit)

RES. NO. 122-80

1 WHEREAS, the Management Board of the Papago Farming Authority has made its
2 regular annual report to the Papago Council, including a report of an
3 audit made by the Bureau of Indian Affairs ("B.I.A.") of costs
4 expended by the Tribe pursuant to 638 contract, contract #H50C14200685,
5 for Phase I, Development Operation of Papago Farms. October 1, 1977
6 through September 30, 1979; and

7 WHEREAS, the Papago Farming Authority is assisting the Tribe in contesting some
8 of the refund demands made by the B.I.A. in said audit.

9 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that the Management Board
10 of the Papago Farming Authority, or its Chairman, report back to the
11 Council, the outcome of audit negotiations with the B.I.A. and the
12 source of funds recommended to cover any repayment obligations to
13 the B.I.A. in January 1981, or as soon thereafter as the audit
14 negotiations are complete.

15 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 5th
16 day of November, 1980, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
17 of 965 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 0 absent, pursuant
18 to the authority vested in the Council by Section 2 (e) and (f) of Article V
19 of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe as amended, ratified by
20 the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the
21 Interior on January 5, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934
(48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of
22 Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago
23 council.
