RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL (Opposing Provisions of Section 708 of Indian Health Care Amendments of 1980, S.2728)

RES, NO. 123-80

1 WHEREAS, The Papago Council has reviewed Section 708 of Senate Bill 2728, the 2 Indian Health Care Amendments of 1980, which Section would require 3 that the State of Arizona be designated as a Contract Health Service 4 Delivery Area and make all Indians in Arizona eligible for contract 5 health care services: and WHEREAS, it is evident from IHS and the Papago Tribe's statistical and financial 6 7 data and projections that, unless Congress appropriates sufficent 8 additional funds to cover the additional contract health care services 9 mandated under the provisions of section 708, the limited funds 10 presently available to members of the Papago Tribe for contract health 11 care services will be further depleted despite the admonition contained in Section 708 (b) that such services not be curtailed. 12 13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it opposes the 14 provision of Section 708 of Senate Bill 2728 and strongly urges 15 Congress, and specifically Congressman Morris K. Udall, and Senator 16 Dennis DeConcini, to do everything within their power to have 17 Section 708 deleted from the proposed Indian Health Care Amendments 18 of 1980. The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 6th day of November, 1980, at a meeting at which a quorum was present, with a vote of 807.5 for; 0 against; 88.5 not voting; and 69. absent, pursuanto the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2(d) of Article V of 20 absent, pursuant the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 21 (48 Stat. 984) Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of Interior and is effective as of the date of it's enactment by the Papago Council. 23 24 THE PAPAGO COUNCIL 25 Max/H.
