RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL (Requesting Appointment of Superintendent)

RES. NO.133-80

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Council did on February 13, 1980, by Resolution No. 9-80 request the removal of Richard Christman as Superintendent of the 2 3 Papago Indian Agency; and WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs has since that date assigned a number of 5 Acting Superintendents to the Agency; and 6 WHEREAS, the failure of the Bureau to find and appoint a qualified person to 7 the permanent position of Superintendent has resulted in administrative indecision, oversight and delays, in a vacuum in leadership, in a 8 9 lack of responsiveness to the needs of Papago people, and in a failure 10 of initiative and enforcement of the trust responsibilities imposed 11 on the Department of Interior by Congress. 12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby appeal 13 directly to the Commissioner and to the Assistant Secretary of the 14 Interior for Indian Affairs that the position of Superintendent of 15 the Papago Indian Agency be declared open for application by qualified 16 persons and that, in consultation with the Papago Council, it be filled 17 forthwith. ¹⁸ The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the day of November, 1980, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 936 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 6 absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 3 (f) of Article V of 20 the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 5, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
