

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL
(Authorizing execution of Noranda
Labor Agreement)

RES. NO. 13-80

1 WHEREAS, Noranda Lakeshore Mines, Inc., ("Noranda") as Lessee under a Mining
2 Lease, Contract No. H50C14201257, and a Business Lease, Contract No.
3 H50C14201258, is obligated as operator of the Lakeshore Mine on the
4 Papago Reservation to ". . . employ Indians, giving priority to (the
5 Papago Tribe as) Lessor and other members of its tribe. . .," and
6 WHEREAS, Noranda and the Papago Tribe desire to clarify Noranda's labor obli-
7 gations under said Contracts,
8 WHEREAS, the Papago Council believes that it would be in the best interest of
9 the Papago Tribe that any agreement entered into with Noranda should
10 be for a limited period of two (2) years to assure the Tribe of
11 Noranda's good faith and if said agreement is performed in good faith
12 the Council could then decide on an extension or modification thereof.
13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Papago Council that it does hereby approve
14 for a two (2) year period only the provisions of the attached agree-
15 ment between Noranda Lakeshore Mines, Inc., and the Papago Tribe does
16 hereby authorize and direct the Chairman or Vice-Chairman and the
17 Secretary of the Papago Council to execute the agreement as modified
18 on behalf of the Papago Tribe.

19 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 3rd
20 day of March, 1980, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with
21 a vote of 965 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 1
22 absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Council by Section 2 (a), (f)
23 and (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe as
24 amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the
25 Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act
26 of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by
27 the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment
28 by the Papago Council.
