

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

(Approving Federal Revenue Sharing )  
(Budget of Schuk Toak District Council)

RES. NO. 138-80

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Council did by Resolution No. 11-80 allocate \$15,753.85  
2 of Federal Revenue Sharing Funds to the Schuk Toak District and did  
3 authorize distribution of said funds upon approval by the Papago  
4 Council of the District Council's request therefore based on the  
5 qualifying priorities expressed at the public Revenue Sharing  
6 hearings; and

7 WHEREAS, the Schuk Toak District Council did adopt the attached Revenue  
8 Sharing Funds Budget in the sum of \$15,753.85 for the District; and

9 WHEREAS, the Papago Council has reviewed and approved said budget.


10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby  
11 approve the attached Revenue Sharing Funds budget, and does hereby  
12 authorize distribution of the sum of \$15,753.85 to the Schuk Toak  
13 District Council in accordance with the attached budget of the  
14 Schuk Toak District Council.

15 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 2nd  
16 day of December, 1980, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote  
17 of 914.5 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 2 absent,  
18 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a), (d)  
19 and (f) and Section 3 (a) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the  
20 Papago Tribe as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936,  
21 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 5, 1937, pursuant to  
22 Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is  
23 not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as  
24 of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
