

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
(Buy Indian Contract - San Simon/Santa Rosa Boarding)
(School, Janitorial and Maintenance Services)

RES. NO. 144-80

1 WHEREAS, it is to the benefit of the Papago Tribe to contract to provide
2 the following:

- 3 1. Grounds maintenance, janitorial services, and refuse
4 disposal services for the San Simon School,
5 2. Grounds maintenance, janitorial services and refuse
6 disposal for the Santa Rosa Boarding School,
7 3. Grounds maintenance and refuse disposal for old
8 Santa Rosa School.

8 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that the Chairman or
9 other designated officers of the Papago Council are hereby
10 authorized to negotiate and sign, on behalf of the Papago Tribe,
11 a contract with the Bureau of Indian Affairs to provide ground
12 maintenance, janitorial services, and disposal services for the
13 San Simon School, and ground maintenance, janitorial services,
14 and refuse disposal for the Santa Rosa Boarding School at
15 both locations.

16 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 15th
17 day of December, 1980, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
18 of 965. for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 0 absent,
19 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a) and
20 (d) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of
21 Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936,
22 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 5, 1937, pursuant
23 to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution
24 is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective
25 as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
