

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
(Building 410 Property of Tribe)

RES. NO. 145-80

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe proposes to use Building No. 410 that is a Bureau
2 of Indian Affairs building, as a janitorial supply warehouse; and

3 WHEREAS, it is possible via this Resolution for that building to be
4 transferred by the Bureau of Indian Affairs to the Tribe for
5 use by the Tribal Maintenance Program in the performance of
6 their work under the Santa Rosa Janitorial Contract; and

7 WHEREAS, said Building No. 410 is located within the compound known as
8 the old Santa Rosa School, is a cement block building; and

9 WHEREAS, said building is a structurally sound building; and

10 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe desires to use the building for storage of
11 their janitorial supplies and/or equipment; and

12 WHEREAS, said building and improvements are no longer used by the Bureau
13 of Indian Affairs and should be the property of the Papago Tribe.

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Tribal Council that the
15 following described building and improvements located in the
16 compound in Santa Rosa Village, Gu Achi District, is hereby
17 transferred, assigned, and set over to the Papago Tribe;
18 Building No. 410, a 24' x 84' concrete block structure.

19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chairman or in his absence the Vice Chairman
20 and the Treasurer of the Papago Tribe are hereby authorized, on
21 behalf of the Papago Tribe, to receive and receipt for any such
22 facilities transferred or assigned to the Papago Tribe by the
23 Bureau of Indian Affairs pursuant to the request contained in
24 this Resolution.

25 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 15th
26 day of December, 1980, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
27 of 965. for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 0 absent,
28 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a) and
29 (d) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of
30 Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and
31 approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 5, 1937, pursuant to
32 Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is
not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as
of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
