

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL
(Contracting Lobbyists for the Education Department)

RES. NO. 17-80

1 WHEREAS, the National Council of Churches, through its Child and Family Justice
2 Project, has advised the Papago Education Committee that it has \$8,000
3 available to the Papago Tribe which could be used for the purpose of
4 lobbying CONGRESS on Papago Education issues and concerns; and

5 WHEREAS, the Papago Education Committee has recommended to the Papago Council
6 that such funds be obtained for such purpose and that Mr. Lance Lujan
7 and Mr. Kirk Kickingbird, presently associated with the Institute for
8 the Development of Indian Law, be retained on an annual basis to lobby
9 CONGRESS on Papago Education issues and concerns,

10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby
11 approve of securing any funds available from the National Council of
12 Churches for the purpose of obtaining the services of Mr. Lance Lujan
13 and Mr. Kirk Kickingbird to lobby CONGRESS on Papago Education issues
14 and concerns,

15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Papago Education Committee is hereby authorized
16 and directed to negotiate a one-year contract with Mr. Lance Lujan and
17 Mr. Kirk Kickingbird to lobby CONGRESS on such education issues and
18 concerns affecting the Papago Tribe as directed by the Papago Educa-
19 tion Committee,


20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman or Vice-Chairman and the Secretary of
21 of the Papago Council are hereby authorized and directed to execute
22 any contract, agreement or instrument necessary or incidental to the
23 purpose of this Resolution.

24 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 7th day
25 March, 1980 at a meeting at which a quorum was present, with a vote of 965 for;
26 0 against; 0 not voting; and 1 absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the
27 authority vested in the Council by Section 2 (a) (d) (e) of Article V of the
28 Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe as amended and ratified by the
Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior
on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48.
Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of the
Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
