WHEREAS, the Papago Council did not consider or set the amount of per diem or the amount of mileage reimbursement to be paid Commissioners; NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Papago Council does hereby ratify the Chairman's appointments of the above mentioned tribal members to the Water Commission and hereby set the per diem to be paid each Commissioner at \$50.00 for each day or portion of each day spent at regularly called Water Commission meetings plus reimbursement of 20¢ per mile for Commissioner vehicles used for Water Commission purposes.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all per diem and mileage reimbursement be paid retroactive for all Commission meetings held since December 27, 1979.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 7th day of March, 1980, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 965 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 1 absent, pursua to the authority vested in the Council by Section 2 (e), (f) and (m) of absent, pursuant Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
