

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL  
(Ft. McDowell - Orme Dam )

RES. NO. 19-80

1 WHEREAS, the State of Arizona has consistently pressed for the construction of  
2 Orme Dam which would flood a significant portion of the Ft. McDowell  
3 Reservation; and

4 WHEREAS, the Ft. McDowell Indian Reservation has consistently resisted the  
5 construction of Orme Dam and fought to preserve their land and heri-  
6 tage; and

7 WHEREAS, the President of the United States previously hereto has eliminated  
8 Orme Dame as a Federal funded project; and

9 WHEREAS, the State of Arizona and other large financial State interests have  
10 recently initiated a pressure movement to have funding reinstated  
11 for the construction of Orme Dam; and

12 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe throughout the years has supported the Ft. McDowell  
13 Indians in their efforts to protect their land and heritage,

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Papago Tribe does hereby support and  
15 back any and all action taken or to be taken by the Ft. McDowell  
16 Indian Tribe in regards to the controversial Orme Dam project.

17 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 20th  
18 day of March, 1980, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of  
19 965 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 1 absent, pursuant to the authority  
20 vested in the Council by Section 2 (a) and (m) of Article V of the Constitution  
21 and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on  
22 December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6,  
23 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said  
24 Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of Interior and is effect-  
25 ive as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
