1	WHEREAS,	the position of the Assistant Secretary for the Bureau of Indian						
2	£	Affairs has been vacated by the resignation of Forrest Gerard; and						
3	WHEREAS,	the Secretary of the Interior, Cecil Andrus, has requested recommenda-						
4		tions from Indian Tribes and Indian Organizations for a qualified						
5		individual to fill the position of Assistant Secretary; and						
6	WHEREAS,	the Papago Tribe, along with many other Indian Tribes, are presently						
7		involved in litigation, negotiation, legislation and other acts to						
8	2 2 2 4	protect, recover and/or prevent the deterioration of its legal right						
9		to water; and						
10	WHEREAS,	it is essential that the position of Assistant Secretary be filled						
11		with a person extremely knowledgeable in all phases of Indian problems						
12		including water; and						
13	WHEREAS,	Tom Fredericks has spent many years fighting for Indian rights both						
14		as an individual Indian, and as the Associate Solicitor for the Bureau						
15		of Indian Affairs; and						
16	WHEREAS,	the Papago Tribal Council, after due consideration, believes that						
17		Tom Fredericks is the best qualified person to be appointed to the						
18		position of Assistant Secretary for the Bureau of Indian Affairs, and						
19		that it would be in the best interest of the Papago Tribe if Tom						
20		Fredericks is appointed to this position.						
21	NOW, THE	REFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Papago Council does hereby recommend						
22		to the Secretary of the Interior, Cecil Andrus, that Tom Fredericks						
23		be appointed to the position of Assistant Secretary for the Bureau						
24		of Indian Affairs.						
25	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that due to the many critical problems facing Indian							
26		Tribes today, that Tom Fredericks' appointment be made as soon as						
27		possible.
