5		of two unpatented mining claims ("mining claims"), Blue Bird #8 and					
6		#9, located in the Ajo Mining District, in the Northeast Quarter of					
7		Section 35, Range 6 West, Township 12 South, GSRB&M, in Pima County,					
8		Arizona; and					
9	WHEREAS,	the Papago Council did, by Resolution No. 16-80, request a determina-					
10		tion of the legal status of said mining claims; and					
11	WHEREAS,	it appears that said mining claims were located on July 1, 1960, by					
12		T. J. Jones on public lands which have historically and continuously					
13		comprised the Sand Papago Community of Soft Well (Mohik Vaya); and					
14	WHEREAS,	T. J. Jones, recognizing the historic and continuing claim of the					
15		Sand Papagos residing on said lands, has agreed to give the Papago					
16		Tribe a two-year option to purchase said mining claims in order to					
17		give the Papago Tribe an opportunity to seek legislative resolution					
18		of said claim.					
19	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby						
20		authorize execution on behalf of the Papago Tribe of the attached					
21		lease and option agreement with T. J. Jones covering the Blue Bird					
22		#8 and #9 Lode Mining Claims.					
23	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Interior is hereby requested						
24		to apply for the withdrawal of the Northeast Quarter of Section 35,					
25		Range 6 West, Township 12 South, GSRB&M, Pima County, Arizona, from					
26		further location, entry, patent or disposition, pursuant to the Act					
27		of June 17, 1902, (32 Stat. 388; 43 U.S.C. 416), or other provisions					
28		of federal law, in order to permit the Papago Tribe to complete entry					
29		and settlement thereof or to seek a legislative solution to its claim					
30		thereto as the historic and continuing site of the Sand Papago					
31		Community of Soft Well (Mohik Vaya).					
32	BE IT FU	JRTHER RESOLVED that the Papago Council does hereby request the support

and cooperation of the Bureau of Land Management and Department of Interior in determining the legal status and best and most economic use of the lands contained in said Quarter Section, and in advising the Papago Council and its officers, attorneys and agents about what legal steps are necessary to have said lands set apart for the use and occupancy of members of the Papago Tribe and made part of the Papago Reservation.

8 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Papago Council does hereby request the Congress 9 of the United States to permanently withdraw the lands contained in 10 said Quarter Section from the public domain and set them apart as an 11 addition to the Papago Reservation for the use and benefit of members 12 of the Papago Tribe.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman, the Secretary, the San Lucy Representatives to the Papago Council, the Mining Director and the
Attorneys for the Papago Tribe are hereby authorized and directed to
take whatever steps are necessary or incidental to the purposes of
this Resolution.

18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Treasurer is hereby authorized to pay T. J.
19 Jones the sums of \$1,500.00 option price, and \$200.00 per year, cost
20 of assessment work, as contemplated by the attached lease and option,
21 and that the FY 1980 budget of the Papago Tribe is hereby amended

to reflect such expenditures.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 7th 23 day of April, 1980, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 914.5 for; 0 against; 50.5 not voting; and 1 absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Council by Sections 2 (a), (d) and (h), and 3 (a) 24 914.5 and (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe as 25 amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of 26 the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is 27 subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior. 28
